

Welcome to the **6th International Archean Symposium** presented by the not-for-profit organization Geoconferences (WA), marking the sixth in a series that began in 1970. The 6IAS is the premier international symposium dedicated to Precambrian geoscience, with a specific focus on the Archean. It is designed to promote discussion and communicate the latest concepts, methodologies and technologies relevant to unlocking the secrets of the Precambrian to all geoscientists.

Symposium themes:

- Early Earth evolution: perspectives from the oldest minerals and rocks
- Emergence of atmosphere and life on early Earth and other terrestrial planets
- Early Earth geodynamics: insights from geochemical, isotopic, phase equilibrium and numerical modelling
- The role of Archean lithosphere in the evolution of younger terranes
- Cratons and craton margins: structure, composition and tectonic history
- Defining the Archean to Proterozoic transition
- Mineral systems of Archean terranes and their margins

Planned field trips

Pre-conference trips:

- Paleoproterozoic reworking of an Archaean craton margin: a transect through the southern Gawler Craton
- Pilbara Craton: evolving Archean tectonic styles

Post-conference trips:

- The Archean-Proterozoic boundary: out with the old, in with the new
- A traverse across the northern Yilgarn Craton in Western Australia: From the Jack Hills to the Youanmi Terrane
- Mineral deposits in the Yilgarn Craton

Hosted in the beautiful city of Perth, Western Australia, the 6IAS will benefit from being located in one of the global capitals of the mineral industry. Like previous Archean symposia, the 6IAS will provide an excellent opportunity to network in the collegial atmosphere that has developed between industry, government and academic professionals from around the globe.

Target 2020: Targeting for a New Era of Discovery

The Target 2020 conference will be held at the Uniclub at the University of Western Australia on 17 July 2020 in Perth, Western Australia following the 6th Archean International Symposium.

After the great success of Target 2017, Geoconferences is organising Target 2020 in collaboration with the Centre for Exploration Targeting to showcase innovations developed to aid the discovery of new tier-one deposits and broaden the exploration search space under cover. Target 2020 will focus on all aspects of mineral exploration and provide a unique opportunity to workshop solutions to the mineral industry challenges that lie ahead.
